- ❖ Applications for testing must be submitted on an official FSC of Rio Rancho test application form. Applications will not be accepted unless accompanied by all required fees, completed application, and if required, a letter of permission or current USFS membership card. You will find these applications on the club bulletin board at The MAC or on our club website "www.fscrrnm.org" (navigate to the 'Downloads' section). Note that credit card payments can be accepted by arrangement.
- ❖ Test application deadlines are at least 2 weeks (14 days) prior to the official scheduled test date. Applicants should check the club website (www.fscrrnm.org) or the FSCRRNM bulletin board at The MAC for the deadline date of each test session. Applications must be mailed or delivered to the Test Chair PRIOR to the application deadline. Applications accepted after this date will be on a first-come, first-serve basis, space permitting. A \$25 dollar late fee will be assessed for filing after the posted deadline.
- ❖ Test fees are NON-REFUNDABLE if a skater cancels the requested test(s) later than 10 days prior to the test date. NO EXECPTIONS.
- ❖ The Test Chair has the right to cancel an entire scheduled test session or an individual test due to (1) unavailability of appropriate judges or (2) lack of sufficient test applications.
- ❖ Once a test begins, coaches and/or parents will not be allowed on the ice except as registered partners for dance/pair tests or in an emergency situation.
- ❖ Skaters must pass the appropriate field move test before taking the corresponding free skate test. When applying for both field moves and free skate, the total fee for both tests must be included in the test application payment. If a skater does not pass the field move tests, the fee for the free skate will not be returned but will carry over for a retake of the same test at a future FSCRRNM testing session.
- ❖ The test schedule will be posted on the club bulletin board at The MAC two days prior to the test date and may also be emailed/phoned to the skaters and coaches.
- ❖ Pursuant to USFS rules, all skaters who are not home club members of FSCRRNM must provide a letter of permission from their home club or a copy of their current year USFS membership card in the case of individual members.
- ❖ Skaters should arrive at the rink at least 40 minutes prior to their scheduled test time. The Test Chair shall not be responsible for a skater missing their test if the test session is running ahead of schedule.
- ❖ A 30-minute pre-test warm-up session may be offered, depending upon time available and the number of skaters interested. If a 30-minute warm-up session is available and you would like to skate in it, the cost will be \$10.00 and must be included with your test application and fees.

- ❖ A \$25 non-member fee will be charged to all skaters who do not belong to the FSCRRNM or any other club based in the state of New Mexico.
- ❖ Coaches are expected to maintain ethical behavior, good sportsmanship and compliance to all rules at all USFSA events. Coaches are expected to have their skaters ready for all tests and inform the parents and/or skaters of changes in test times, in instances where the test session is either ahead of schedule or behind schedule. Coaches are not allowed to speak to judges or test chair prior to or during the skater testing. Coaches are not allowed to enter the area where the judges are tabulating the results of a skaters test.
- ❖ Please understand that coaching or attempting to coach at a U.S. Figure Skating sanctioned event and/or activity without being coach compliant is an ethics violation and will be reported to U.S. Figure Skating and PSA
